## POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS THESE CANDIDATES

Howard Jarvis, the principle author of Proposition 13, founded the Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Association as the legal and political watchdog over landmark tax-limiting measures. He also founded the legally separate Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Association Political Action Committee (HJTA-PAC) to help candidates who, when elected, would support Proposition 13 and defend the interests of taxpayers.
